Today, Friday, October 30, Atlantic Coast Pipeline submitted a supplemental filing to the FERC that provides route alternatives, variations and adjustments in several areas to avoid environmental impacts and address other public land use concerns.

The adjustments include a variation in the Warminster/Swift Island area to avoid impacts within a wetland mitigation site and potential impacts on the newly identified, proposed Warminster Rural Historic District, both along the James River in Nelson and Buckingham counties. Attached are the press release, which includes information on additional route adjustments and the full supplemental filing.

Additionally, today's filing provides an update on the status of the environmental field surveys Atlantic has conducted along the proposed route, as well as the anticipated filing dates for survey reports. These include updates on archaeological field surveys and surveys for rare, threatened and endangered species.
