



# Incident Objectives

1. **TESTING:** Develop community testing and point prevalence surveillance strategies in accordance with the Governor's priorities.
2. **CONTACT TRACING:** Develop a contact strategy to keep the rate of spread within the capability of existing healthcare capacity.
3. **MEDICAL SURGE:** Continue to support and refine medical surge plans in collaboration with hospitals, long-term care facilities, correctional facilities and other congregate settings in the community..
4. **EQUITY: EQUALITY AND ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS:** Ensure all operations are actively centered on and consider impacts to the most under resourced individuals and communities. Integrate, prioritize, measure, and validate equitable and ethical practices for all response and recovery decisions, actions, and resource allocation.
5. **SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT:** Maintain and adapt strategies to ensure supplies of goods and materials can meet an evolving demand environment.
6. **FEDERAL AID AND RECOVERY PROGRAMS:** Begin working with local governments and other eligible applicants for federal aid.
7. **SUSTAINMENT:** Prepare to maintain operations for the remainder of the year and respond to any secondary outbreaks and other emergencies.
8. **Safety:** Keep the citizens of the Commonwealth's health and safety and that of incident personnel a top priority in all decisions and actions.


# COVID-19 Organizational Chart

# ESF-8 Public Health and Medical Updates

- Governor Northam today announced a temporary statewide moratorium on all eviction proceedings in Virginia. The Governor requested this moratorium in a [letter](#) sent to Virginia Supreme Court Chief Justice Donald Lemons this weekend.
- The Chief Justice's [order](#) issued today remains in effect through June 28 and modifies the Court's earlier Declaration of Judicial Emergency in response to COVID-19. The temporary moratorium will halt all eviction proceedings for a period of nearly three weeks, as the Northam administration implements a comprehensive rent relief program for the thousands of Virginians facing housing insecurity in the midst of this public health crisis.

# COVID-19 Workgroup Updates

- **Healthcare Coordination**

- Efforts continue to expand testing within community pharmacies.
- Remdesivir continues to be received from HHS and distributed through the VDH Division of Pharmacy Services in accordance with the distribution plan. As of June 8, 10,600 vials have been received.

- **Public Health Surveillance & Guidance**


- Workgroup continues to ensure that case investigation, contact tracing, monitoring, point prevalence surveys, and public health and commercial laboratory testing efforts are expanded through additional staffing, resource acquisition, and public outreach and education.
- Efforts continue to improve case investigation and contact tracing efforts by recruiting additional staff, adjusting policies, and developing a marketing campaign to encourage public compliance.
- Modeling information shows that days from onset to diagnosis have dropped ~30% in recent weeks, suggesting increased testing is improving detection. Preliminary estimates suggest the numbers of new infections can be reduced 20-30% with improved isolation of cases (10% more) and moderate compliance (10-18%) of contacts.
- Contact tracer recruitment efforts are ongoing. Position descriptions and guidelines for applying are available on the [VDH website](#).

# COVID-19 Workgroup Updates

- **Governor's Long-Term Care Task Force**
  - Point Prevalence Surveys (PPS) are being conducted at long-term care facilities to test all residents and staff, regardless of whether symptoms are being displayed or not.
  - In response to recent CMS guidance on testing and reopening long-term care facilities, the Task Force is working on clear and concise guidance for Virginia's long-term care facilities to implement such testing recommendations and begin phased reopening.
  - The Task Force has developed guidance for Virginia's long-term care facilities in addition to a playbook to support facilities' response efforts. These materials can be accessed on the [Task Force's website](#).
- **Community Mitigation**
  - The VDH Schools, Workplaces and Community Locations [webpage](#) has been updated.
  - Most of Virginia entered Phase Two of the Forward Virginia plan on Friday, June 5. Northern Virginia and the City of Richmond remain in Phase One to allow for additional monitoring of health data. Phase Two guidelines for specific sectors can be found [here](#). ## Total Cases by Date Reported


Number of new cases VDH reported by day.



## Total Deaths by Date Reported


Number of new deaths VDH reported by day.



## Number of Deaths by Date of Death


