





# Incident Objectives

(updated 5/12)

1. **TESTING:** Develop community testing and point prevalence surveillance strategies in accordance with the Governor's priorities.
2. **CONTACT TRACING:** Develop a contact strategy to keep the rate of spread within the capability of existing healthcare capacity.
3. **MEDICAL SURGE:** Continue to support and refine hospital system medical surge plans and planning and logistics requirements for alternate care facilities.
4. **EQUITY AND ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS:** Ensure all operations are actively centered on and consider impacts to the most under resourced individuals and communities. Integrate, prioritize, measure, and validate equitable and ethical practices for all response and recovery decisions, actions, and resource allocation.
5. **SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT:** Maintain and adapt strategies to ensure supplies of goods and materials can meet an evolving demand environment.
6. **FEDERAL AID AND RECOVERY PROGRAMS:** Begin working with local governments and other eligible applicants for federal aid.
7. **SUSTAINMENT:** Prepare to maintain operations for the remainder of the year and respond to any secondary outbreaks and other emergencies.

# COVID-19 Organizational Chart




# ESF-8 Public Health & Medical Updates

- Governor Northam today issued [Executive Order Sixty-Two](#), allowing specific localities in Northern Virginia to delay entering Phase One of the “Forward Virginia” plan.
  - In conjunction with this executive order, Governor Northam and State Health Commissioner Oliver also issued Order of Public Health Emergency Number Four.
  - Data show that Northern Virginia is substantially higher than the rest of the Commonwealth in percentage of positive tests for COVID-19. The Northern Virginia Region has about a 25 percent positivity rate, while the rest of the Commonwealth is closer to 10 percent. Further, in the last 24 hours, the Northern Virginia Region reported over 700 cases, while the rest of the Commonwealth reported approximately 270. On any given day, 70 percent of the Commonwealth’s positive cases are attributable to the Northern Virginia Region.



## Confirmed Cases by Date of Symptom Onset








## Total Deaths by Date Reported

Number of new deaths VDH reported by day.




## Number of Deaths by Date of Death









# COVID-19 Workgroup Updates

- **Healthcare Coordination**
  - A workgroup has been established to develop guidance and a distribution strategy for remdesivir, a drug with FDA emergency use authorization for the treatment of suspected or laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 in adults and children hospitalized with severe disease.
- **Public Health Surveillance & Guidance**
  - VDH is recruiting for 1,300 contractors in these areas: COVID-19 case investigator (district), COVID-19 contact tracer (district), COVID-19 testing coordinator (regional), COVID-19 contact tracing supervisor (regional), COVID-19 data manager (district), COVID-19 analytics coordinator (regional). Interested applicants can contact a staffing agency listed [here](#) and indicate that they want to apply for a COVID-19 position with VDH. Current state employees seeking temporary reassignment can apply at [jobs.virginia.gov](https://jobs.virginia.gov).
- **Community Mitigation**
  - Guidance continues to be developed for various business and community sectors (K-12 schools, DMV, institutions of higher education, migrant labor camps, seafood processors, etc.)

# COVID-19 Workgroup Updates

- **Testing Capacity & Coordination**
  - Testing capacity continues to increase with recent agreements with commercial laboratories. Two of these contracts will provide lab processing services and 30,000 collection kits with weekly deliveries commencing 5/11/20.
- **Provider Outreach & Detailing**
  - The Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) continues to recruit and deploy medical and non-medical volunteers to bolster the work of local health departments, hospitals, and healthcare providers.
