

NELSON COUNTY ELECTORAL BOARD

Meeting Minutes

April 27, 2026

I. Call to order

Chair Smith called to order the Regular meeting of the Nelson County Electoral Board at 10:01 am on April 27, 2026 at the Office of the Registrar.

II. Roll call

Secretary Greene conducted a roll call. Present: William Smith, Chair; Mary Reinman, Vice Chair; Susan Greene, Secretary; Jackie Harris, General Registrar and Rachael Snapp, Chief Deputy Registrar.

III. Adopt Agenda

Secretary Greene requested adding a closed session to discuss the upcoming Performance Evaluation of the General Registrar. Secretary Greene moved to adopt the agenda as amended and it was unanimously approved by the Board.

IV. Recognition of Any Visitors

There were no visitors at the meeting.

V. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes

Vice Chair Reinman moved to approve the minutes from 04/14/2026 as presented. The motion was approved by Vice Chair Reinman and Secretary Greene (Chair Smith abstained, having been absent at the 04/14/26 meeting). Secretary Greene moved to approve the minutes from the 04/01/26 meeting as presented, and the motion was unanimously approved by the Board.

VI. Conclude Canvass of Results from the April 21, 2026 Special Election

The Board continued canvassing the results of the April 21 election adding all CAP by mail, CAP early voting and post-CAP election results to the State total. The open meeting was suspended at 10:45 to go into closed session for matters of personnel.

VII. Closed Session to discuss Upcoming Performance Evaluation of the General Registrar

At 10:45 am Chair Smith moved that the Electoral Board go into closed session pursuant to State Code Sections 2.2-3711(A)(1) for the purpose of discussing issues related to personnel and that the General Registrar Jackie Harris be allowed to remain in the room. Vice Chair Reinman seconded the motion, and the Board went into closed session at 10:46 am.

At 11:21 am Chair Smith moved that the Electoral Board return to public session and certify that only public business matters lawfully exempt from open meeting requirements by Virginia Law, and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed session were heard, discussed or considered. The motion was seconded by Vice Chair Reinman and unanimously approved by the Board and a roll call was taken by Secretary Greene to certify the closed session.

VIII. Completion of Canvass

The Board resumed canvassing the election results, recessed at 11:32 am and reconvened at 3:00 pm to complete the canvass of the April 21, 2026 Special Election. The Board verified that all counts were correct and Secretary Greene attested the results.
